SCCLF will consider any projects within its four areas of focus: affordable housing, healthy food enterprises, community businesses, and community facilities. However, priority will be given to the following projects:

Affordable Housing: Multi-family construction loans

Healthy Food Enterprises: Food access projects located in USDA designated food deserts

Community Facilities: Charter school facilities and community health centers

Community Businesses: Business loans in low to moderate income neighborhoods; hiring low to moderate income residents
